- 1. Meeting began at 6:00 promptly with Co-Chair Jodie Defeo opening the session with a land acknowledgment.
- 2. Review of the August 25, 2025, minutes, approved and passed unanimously. August 28, 2025, minutes were deferred to next meeting as there was an email sent for additional language to be added.
- 3. Introduction of new Committee Members: Co-Chair Jodie Defeo welcomed Heidi West, Dana Caines, and Maddison Hazelaar to the Committee.
- 4. Presentation from Skills Ontario: Ashley Cuglietta presented to the committee, explaining what Skills Ontario is about and what to expect at the 3-day Youth Nuclear Symposium Skilled Trades and Tech Days. This event will be held Nov 18-20, 2025, at the end of the event a youth strategy will be completed and presented to Council, this strategy will be added to the strategic plan.
- 5. NWMO Update: Chantelle Gascon provided updates on NWMO activities and upcoming engagement opportunities as well as an update on the Community Celebration BBQ being held Sept 27th from 10am-3pm.

- 6. Engagement Opportunities: Diana and Yvonne gave an update on the Community Celebration and how the Committee can help. The Committee will oversee the games which will start at noon; looking for volunteers to organize and run the games. Jodie, Diana, Yvonne, Dana, Janet, and Shelley to help with this. Jake to reach out to Silver Tops for opportunities to meet; discuss what is happening, who sits on committee etc.
 - Questions: Are there goals, number of events for engagement the Committee does? Fireside chats will be happening in the fall. Set out a half hour next meeting to discuss engagement opportunities and produce a schedule for 2025, 2026.
- 7. Communications Update:
 - i. Newsletter: This is a work in progress, there is a CEC section, which will include information about the committee, engagement, how some of the money that the town received was spent etc. Second edition should be out by first week of October, hard copies available at the town office and library. Suggested we add Robins, the food bank and possibly the school (Jodie and Maddison to meet with Mrs. Marth to see if that is possible). Jake to reach out to administration to see if the Committee could have a small amount of resources for engagement etc. Question asked: Does CEC have an email for questions, suggestions etc.? Not currently.
 - ii. Centre of Expertise: presentation to Council has happened to discuss location. Closer to site selection we are expecting an event, perhaps sometime this fall.
 - iii. Housing NRFP Update: Negotiated Request for Proposal sent out and there has been quite a bit of interest. Jake will continue to provide updates the committee.
 - iv. Website Update: We are making progress on the website update, received positive comments. CEC has a section where the meeting agendas, minutes and events can be posted. There will be a proposal to develop the backend going to council in the future.
