Candidates must have the following minimum qualifications:

- Grade 12 Secondary School Diploma or equivalent
- Experience in cleaning and maintaining indoor facilities such as arenas, curling rink, banquet hall and kitchen facilities, and fitness facilities.
- Understanding and knowledge of refrigeration equipment and operation of that equipment

- Experience operating heavy equipment (loader/ backhoe/ truck)
