The Township of Ignace Has Filed an Application to the Supreme Court of Canada

Dufault vs. Township of Ignace

The Township of Ignace is pursuing an appeal of the Dufault case to the country's highest court, the Supreme Court of Canada, due to its public importance.

The Township of Ignace has filed an Application for Leave to Appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada. Once all responding materials have been delivered, the Supreme Court will decide whether it will hear the appeal. The Township anticipates having a decision on its application sometime in the late spring 2025.
