The **Seasonal Grounds Technician** role with the Township of Ignace's **Parks & Recreation Department** offers a fantastic opportunity to gain hands-on experience in municipal operations, develop practical skills, and contribute meaningfully to the beautification of public spaces.

In this role, you'll assist with maintaining parks, trails, cemeteries, and other municipal grounds, while also supporting the setup and takedown of recreational and community events. This is more than just a summer job — it's a great introduction to the field of municipal work and public service. You'll work alongside experienced staff, learn the importance of safety and teamwork, and build a foundation for future roles in government, landscaping, or recreation.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform landscaping tasks including grass cutting, trimming, weeding, and watering throughout municipal parks, cemeteries, trails, and public spaces.
- Plant, maintain, and care for flower beds, shrubs, and trees.
- Operate hand tools and small landscaping equipment (e.g., trimmers, push mowers) safely and responsibly.
- Remove litter, branches, and debris to maintain cleanliness and safety of outdoor areas.
- Support seasonal maintenance duties such as trail clearing and general grounds cleanup.



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- Assist with operating the municipal canteen during events when required, including: preparing and serving food and beverages, handling cash and accurately recording sales, Monitoring and restocking inventory and supplies.
- Cleaning and maintaining the canteen area in accordance with health standards.
- Assist with setup and takedown of community and recreational events (e.g., moving tables, tents, signage, and garbage bins).
- Follow all health and safety protocols as directed by supervisors.
- Ensure compliance with municipal policies and procedures.
- Provide friendly and efficient customer service to community members.
- Carry out other duties as assigned by the Manager of Infrastructure and Public Works.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a student currently enrolled in school and returning in the fall.
- Physically capable of performing outdoor work in all weather conditions.
- Demonstrates responsibility, initiative, and willingness to learn.
- Strong communication skills and ability to work both independently and as part of a team.

- First Aid and CPR certification is an asset.
- Availability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends.
